<b>Ackle Bend</b> <b>Map Ref: J17</b> Wimmera River, Dimboola T. 131 963 (Parks Vic)	▲	Basic facilities are provided at park campgrounds at Ackle Bend, south of Dimboola. Fees apply. Walkers can continue past Ackle Bend and follow the track a further 1km to the river before returning to the campgrounds.
<b>Baileys Rock</b> <b>Map Ref: E21</b> Dergholm State Park	FREE ▲	Camp, have a picnic or explore the large 500 million year old granite rocks at Baileys Rocks. Toilets, water, barbecues and picnic tables are provided.
<b>Beulah Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: L13</b> Beulah Recreation Reserve T. (03) 5390 2430	▲	Situated on the foreshore of the Yarrambiack Creek, this relaxing park is perfect for all age groups. The walking track features painted sporting bollards and outdoor exercise equipment.
<b>Bills Gully</b> <b>Map Ref: G17</b> South Miram Rd, Kaniva	▲	Historic Bills Gully Hall and Reserve is a quiet place to stop and relax. Take a walk around the small waterhole and explore the local flora and fauna.
<b>Birchip Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: P13</b> Sunraysia Hwy, Birchip T. (03) 5492 2566	▲	Offers the luxury of either motel accommodation or onsite vans as well as caravan and camping facilities. There is the option of meals to your room, a kiosk, petrol, diesel and gas fuel supplies, a laundromat and gas cylinder filling.
<b>Brim - Redda's Park Camping</b> <b>Map Ref: L14</b> Brim West Road, Brim T. (03) 5390 4212	▲	This amazing bush camp is located on the banks of the picturesque Yarrambiack Creek and is well regarded by travellers as a "must stop spot" along the Henty Highway.
<b>Broken Creek</b> <b>Map Ref: F13</b> Big Desert National Park T. 131 963 (Parks Vic)	▲	Located in the Big Desert Wilderness Reserve is used for overnight camping or a day visit. Broken Creek Reserve has toilets, wood BBQs, picnic tables, fire places and a dam. There are no facilities or water provided in the park, so you need to carry in your own supplies.
<b>Broughton's Waterhole</b> <b>Map Ref: E17</b> McDonald Hwy, 4x4 Only	FREE ▲	4WD access only. Broughtons Water Hole features rare orchids and an abundance of native wildflowers in spring. It is a popular camping ground with seating and fireplaces.
<b>Charlton Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: S15</b> Midlura Way, Charlton T. 0448 276 631	▲	This traditional caravan park located across the river from the Charlton Travellers Rest Caravan Park. Access to facilities is gained by phoning the number on the notice board.
<b>Charlton Travellers Rest Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: S15</b> Davies St, Charlton T. 0448 276 631	▲	The park provides Ensuite facilities, TV antenna connections for better reception, a clothes line and a CMCA Dump Point. There is a CMCA Dollarwise section for self-contained motor homes and caravans at the rear of the park.
<b>Dimboola - Riverside Holiday Park</b> <b>Map Ref: J16</b> 2 Wimmera St, Dimboola T. (03) 5389 1416	▲	Nestled on the banks of the Wimmera River, this beautifully maintained holiday park offers powered and unpowered sites along with 6 berth family cabins and an all abilities access cabin (cabins available from June 2017). <b>Donald Lakeside Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: P16</b> 2 Corack Rd, Donald	▲	Park by the lake has a CMCA dump point. Home to swans and other water birds it is a good fishing spot, in walking distance to the shops, restaurants, sporting facilities and tourist attractions.
<b>Edenhope Lakeside Tourist Park</b> <b>Map Ref: E20</b> Lake St, Edenhope T. (03) 5585 1659	▲	Halfway between Adelaide and Melbourne situated on the bank of Lake Wallace. Ensuite cabins and shady sites with a camp kitchen and rec room. Central to shops, bowls, tennis courts, golf and the swimming pool. The perfect place to relax.
<b>Four Mile Beach Camping</b> <b>Map Ref: I14</b> Lake Hindmarsh, Jeparit T. 0458 565 889	▲	Lake Hindmarsh is Victoria's largest freshwater lake, an extremely popular spot for holiday makers, teeming with wildlife. Four-Mile Beach is the most popular area and has good facilities. Camping fees apply. Access is restricted to dry weather conditions.
<b>Goroke Apex Accommodation</b> <b>Map Ref: F18</b> Park, Main St T. 0429 672 791	▲	This community accommodation park is located within 5 mins walk of the shops, local playground, bowling green and next door to the tennis courts and swimming pool.
<b>Green Lake Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: P11</b> T. (03) 5070 1068	▲	Green Lake is a small attractive wetland centered on 320ha of native bushland 10 kilometres South of Sea Lake. It has powered and unpowered sites, showers, picnic/BQ areas, bush walks, gum trees and shade.
<b>Green Swamp</b> <b>Map Ref: D16</b> South Lillimur Rd, Kaniva	▲	A peaceful camping spot and a popular spot for wildlife and photographers.
<b>Harrow Johnny Mullagh Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: G20</b> Blair St, Harrow T. (03) 5588 1251	▲	Providing powered/ unpowered sites plus a self contained cabin, the park has an excellent amenities block all located a stones throw from the Glenelg River with fishing, abundant birdlife, river walk and majestic red gums.

<b>Hopetoun Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: L12</b> Austin St, Hopetoun T. 0417 237 587	▲	Located a short walk to Lake Lascelles, the park provides excellent facilities. Tourist information is located in the laundry area.
<b>Hopetoun Mallee Bush Retreat</b> <b>Map Ref: L12</b> Lake Lascelles T. 0439 529 973	▲	Camp or utilise the unique accommodation options that represent the pioneering heritage of the area. Free camping is permitted around the perimeter of Lake Lascelles if you are not situated on powered sites.
<b>Horseshoe Bend</b> <b>Map Ref: J16</b> Wimmera River, Dimboola T. 131 963 (Parks Vic)	▲	Horseshoe Bend is on the eastern boundary of Little Desert National Park, on the Wimmera River opposite Wall State Forest. North of here is the Pomperoyne Hill Nature Walk, which takes in a scenic lookout and some of the park's exceptional desert flora.
<b>Jeparit - Sir Robert Menzies Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: I14</b> Peterson Ave T. (03) 5397 2193	▲	Situated next to the Wimmera River and local sporting facilities there is plenty to see and do. Both powered and unpowered sites and new cabins are now available.
<b>Kaneira Hotel, Culgoa</b> <b>Map Ref: Q12</b> 24 Main St, Culgoa T. (03) 5077 2330	▲	The Kaneira Hotel offers free areas for camping and caravanning in their yard immediately adjacent to the Hotel.
<b>Kaniva Poolside Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: E16</b> Cnr Baker & Budjik Street T. 0458 687 054	▲	This quiet park overlooks a beautiful farming landscape and with only a short 5 min walk to the main street. It is located next to the Kaniva Swimming Pool and across the road from the tennis courts. There is a camp kitchen, laundry and a "dump site". Pets are welcomed.
<b>Kiata Camping Rest</b> <b>Map Ref: H16</b> Little Desert National Park T. 131 963 (Parks Vic)	▲	Basic facilities are provided at park campgrounds south of Kiata, Horseshoe Bend. A fee applies.
<b>Lake Bringalbert</b> <b>Map Ref: D19</b> Bringalbert Rd, Via Apsley	▲	Boating, skiing, fishing, swimming and the opportunity for you to relax.
<b>Lake Charlegrark Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: E18</b> Kaneiva Edenhope Rd, Mininmay T. (03) 5386 6281	▲	Cottages as well as powered and unpowered sites are available on the banks of Lake Charlegrark nestled in amongst picturesque farmland. Enjoy the tranquility, indulge in fishing, skiing, yabbying, bird watching only 12kms to the Little Desert.
<b>Lake Ratzcastle</b> <b>Map Ref: F19</b> Natimuk Francis Rd & Western Hwy	▲	Boating, skiing, fishing, swimming and the opportunity for you to relax. Excellent amenities, boat ramps, swimming, fishing, camping and jetty
<b>Lascelles Campground</b> <b>Map Ref: M11</b> Sunraysia Hwy, Lascelles T. (03) 5081 6242	▲	Located adjacent to the historic Minapre Hotel, the Lascelles Campground provides excellent facilities for travellers along the Sunraysia Highway.
<b>Little Desert Nature Lodge</b> <b>Map Ref: G17</b> Little Desert National Park T. (03) 5391 5232	▲	Situated on the edge of the pristine Little Desert National Park, you will find the Lodge to be a peaceful and relaxing base for your next adventure.
<b>Lochiel Rest Stop</b> <b>Map Ref: I16</b> Lochiel, Western Highway	▲	A large level reserve by the culturally significant Wimmera River. Open area with some shade from mature River Red Gum and Black Box trees with a scattered understory of wattle and brush.
<b>Minyip Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: M16</b> Petering St, Minyip T. 0499 010 643	▲	Situated in the Minyip Wetland's, the park provides a variety of free activities. Outdoor exercise equipment is located around walking tracks and fishing is permitted in the ponds.
<b>Moore Reserve</b> <b>Map Ref: D16</b> South Lillimur Rd, Kaniva	▲	Moore Reserve is a historic picturesque picnic area situated around dark green lagoons and shaded by huge red gums.
<b>Murtoa Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: L17</b> 47 Lake St, Murtoa T. 0448 511 879	▲	Situated on the banks of Lake Marna, this waterside park provides a peaceful setting for all travellers.
<b>Nhill Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: G15</b> 93 Victoria St, Nhill T. (03) 5391 1683	▲	The Nhill Caravan Park has powered, unpowered sites and ensuite sites. The park is pet friendly. Nhill is located half way between Melbourne and Adelaide, on the Western Highway, Seniors discount card.
<b>Nhill RV Camping Area</b> <b>Map Ref: G15</b> Propodollah Rd, Nhill T. (03) 5391 1683	▲	Nhill's official RV site is nestled in the grounds of the Historic WWII RAAF training base adjacent to the Nhill Aviation Heritage Centre.
<b>Pier Milan Post Office Free Campsite</b> <b>Map Ref: N9</b> Lot one Pier Milan - Chinkapook Rd T. 0447 850 308	▲	Free caravan or camping site for those who want to get a little off the main highway.
<b>O.T.I.T.</b> <b>Map Ref: I12</b> Lake Albalcutya T. 131 963 (Parks Vic)	▲	Good place to camp for an adventurous hike north of Lake Albalcutya and into the large sand dunes beyond.

<b>Patchewollock Mallee Sunset Retreat</b> <b>Map Ref: K10</b> T. 0499 110 807	▲	Located on the old primary school site, provides 16 powered sites.
<b>Picnic Point Camping Area</b> <b>Map Ref: I14</b> Lake Hindmarsh, Jeparit T. 131 963 (Parks Vic)	▲	Picnic Point Beach, which lies just north of where the Wimmera River empties into Lake Hindmarsh, is a good place for some solitude. Access is restricted to dry weather conditions.
<b>Rainbow Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: J13</b> Station St, Rainbow T. (03) 5395 1062	▲	This pet friendly caravan park offers both powered and unpowered sites and excellently maintained facilities with caretaker's onsite. A perfect, quiet getaway retreat.
<b>Riverside Host Farm</b> <b>Map Ref: J16</b> 150 Riverside Rd, Dimboola T. (03) 5389 1550	▲	This friendly working farm on a bend in the Wimmera River is a lovely place to stay with cosy self-contained camps, camp sites and a rustic open-sided camp kitchen lounge area with pot-belly stove.
<b>Rupanyup Memorial Park</b> <b>Map Ref: M17</b> Wimmera Hwy, Rupanyup	▲	Located between the Jack Emmett Bilibong and Woods Farming and Heritage Museum, this charming park is an ideal base for exploring Rupanyup and surrounding Wimmera townships.
<b>Schulzes Beach</b> <b>Map Ref: I14</b> Lake Hindmarsh, Jeparit T. 131 963 (Parks Vic)	▲	This campground is located on the western shore of Lake Hindmarsh, where it has some impressive red gums for company.
<b>Sea Lake Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: S11</b> 15 Best St, Sea Lake T. 0467 610 882	▲	Situated just a short walk from the shops, cafes and hotels in the town centre. The park has shower toilet and laundry facilities, a CMCA dump Point and powered and unpowered sites for campers.
<b>Serviceton Camping Ground Recreations Reserve</b> <b>Map Ref: D16</b> T. 03 5393 1329 or 0419 032 418	▲	This community run facility located on the Serviceton Recreation Reserve has powered and unpowered sites, toilets and showers with a games room, oval and tennis courts all only minutes walk from the local general store and historic railway station.
<b>Tochum Lake Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: Q14</b> Birchip/Wycheproof Rd, Birchip T. (03) 5392 2767	▲	Tochum Lake is eight kilometres east of Birchip on the Birchip/Wycheproof road. It is a popular destination with a lawn area from caravan and camping sites to the beach. Activities include walking, swimming, fishing, waterskiing and windsurfing.
<b>Warracknabeal Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: L15</b> 2 Lyle St, Warracknabeal T. 0400 915 125	▲	Set on the banks of the picturesque Yarrambiack Creek, the park provides outstanding facilities including ensuites. The study gums secure the relaxing atmosphere that travellers love.
<b>Watchem Lake Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: P14</b> Watchem/Warrack Rd T. 0408 381 293	▲	Watchem Lake has powered camping facilities. The lake is small but the island in the centre breaks the waves created by speed boats and makes it a good lake for waterskiing. Great amenities and shelters are located along the foreshore.
<b>Wattles Camping Area</b> <b>Map Ref: I13</b> Lake Hindmarsh T. 131 963 (Parks Vic)	▲	There's dry weather access only, so check conditions with Parks Victoria.
<b>Western Beach</b> <b>Map Ref: I12</b> Lake Albalcutya T. 131 963 (Parks Vic)	▲	This popular camping ground has the advantage of sealed road access and plenty of native vegetation.
<b>Williamsons Beach</b> <b>Map Ref: I13</b> Lake Hindmarsh T. 131 963 (Parks Vic)	▲	Note the lack of facilities here. Access road is sometimes inaccessible after rain; check before you visit.
<b>Woomelang Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: N12</b> Cnr Gloucester Ave & Proctor St T. 0417 440 445	▲	This free park is located adjacent to the local bowling green and is only a short walk to the General Store & Cafe.
<b>Woomelang-Cronomby Tanks</b> <b>Map Ref: N12</b> Woomelang-Hopetoun Rd	▲	Cronomby Tanks was originally a precinct where steam trains reloaded water supplies but today it's a rugged sanctuary where people can camp for free, picnic, bird watch and bush walk.
<b>Wycheproof Caravan Park</b> <b>Map Ref: R14</b> Calder Hwy, Wycheproof T. (03) 5493 7278	▲	Wycheproof Caravan Park is the ideal place for you to visit and is perfect for families, overnight stays and travellers of all ages. We hope you enjoy your holiday whether it is a short stay or a getaway.
<b>Yaapeet Beach</b> <b>Map Ref: J12</b> Lake Albalcutya T. 131 963 (Parks Vic)	▲	The park is popular for four wheel driving, trail bikes, bush walking and family camping.
<b>Yaapeet Camping Ground, Yaapeet Recreation Reserve</b> <b>Map Ref: F7</b> T. 0429 957 278	▲	This bush camp provides excellent family facilities and an outback ambience travellers will enjoy. The campground is situated in close proximity to the Wyperfeld National Park.
<b>Yanyp Nature Reserve</b> <b>Map Ref: D10</b> Edenhope Rd, 4x4 Only	▲	Excellent camping ground to get away from the hustle and bustle and relax and commune with nature. Linked walking tracks extend from the camp area with an orienteering leaflet available inside the hut.
